

MINI TRAFFIC CIRCLE

MINI TRAFFIC CIRCLES are raised or delineated islands placed at minor street intersections. They encourage slower vehicle movements and manage conflicts at the intersection so that users may enter in all directions with a yield on entry control. Raised island design can vary and may include mountable curbs or aprons, landscaping, and signage.

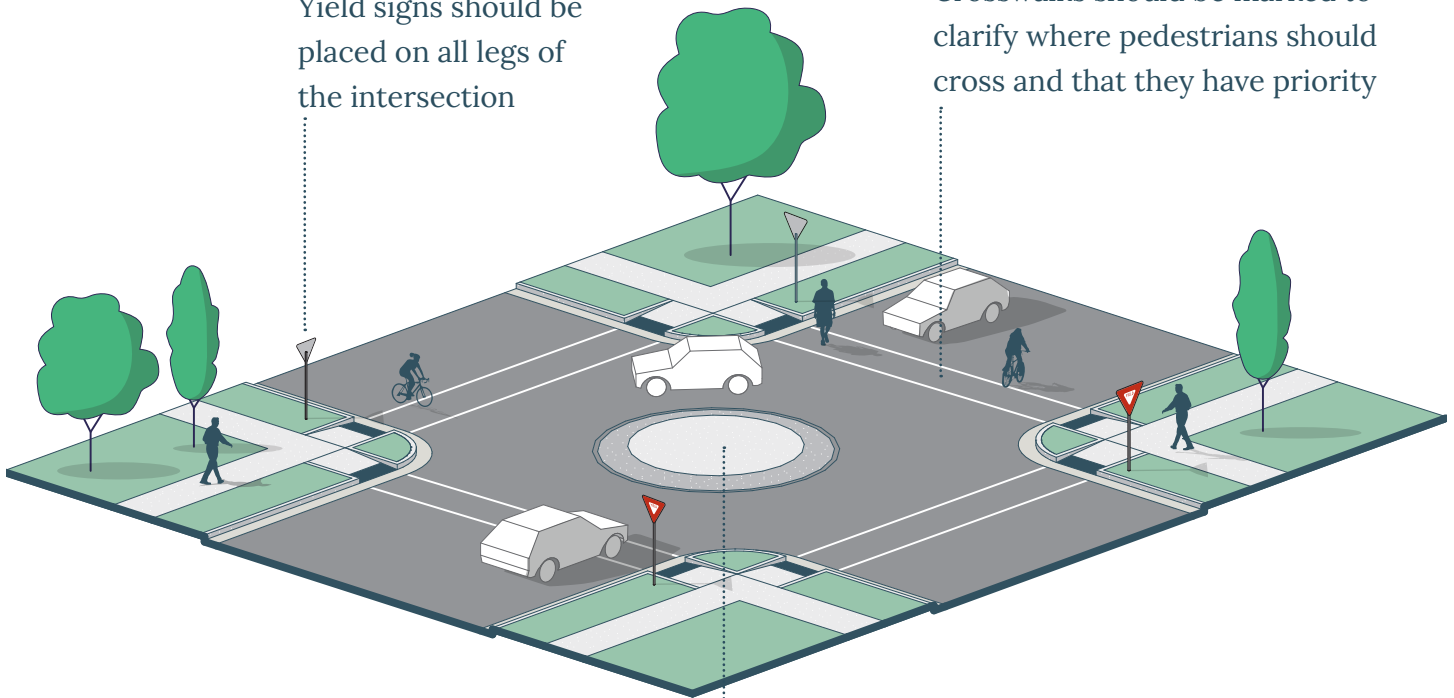

YIELD SIGNAGE

Yield signs should be placed on all legs of the intersection

CROSSWALKS

Crosswalks should be marked to clarify where pedestrians should cross and that they have priority



DESIGN ELEMENTS

Raised island design can vary and may include mountable curbs or aprons, signage, or landscaping. Any design elements included in the traffic circle (plants, public art, etc.) should not prevent visibility from any direction.
